What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the **Pathfinder Global Responsibility Fund** has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Pathfinder Asset Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

The Fund invests in international equities and listed property that satisfy Pathfinder's ethical investment criteria. It achieves this by investing in Pathfinder's wholesale Responsible Investment Fund.

What are the risks of investing?



Annual Return Graph


Example of how this applies to an investor

Angela had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Angela received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$770 (that is 7.70% of her initial \$10,000). Angela did not pay any other charges. This gives Angela a total return after charges and tax of \$662 for the year.

The top 10 investments make up 22.88% of the net asset value of the fund.

Currency hedging: Changes in the value of the NZ dollar relative to other currencies can have a big impact on your investment over the long term. The target currency hedging level implemented in the fund is 50% of foreign currency exposures (actual hedging level at 30 June 2025 was 10.05%, this will change over time). The unhedged foreign currency exposure is 84.07% of the Net Asset Value of the Fund at 30 June 2025 (this will change over time).
