What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Default Fund has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Fisher Funds Management Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

The fund aims to provide a balance between stability of returns and growing your investment over the long term by investing in a mix of income and growth assets. An enhanced passive investment style may be used at times.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Default Fund¹:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

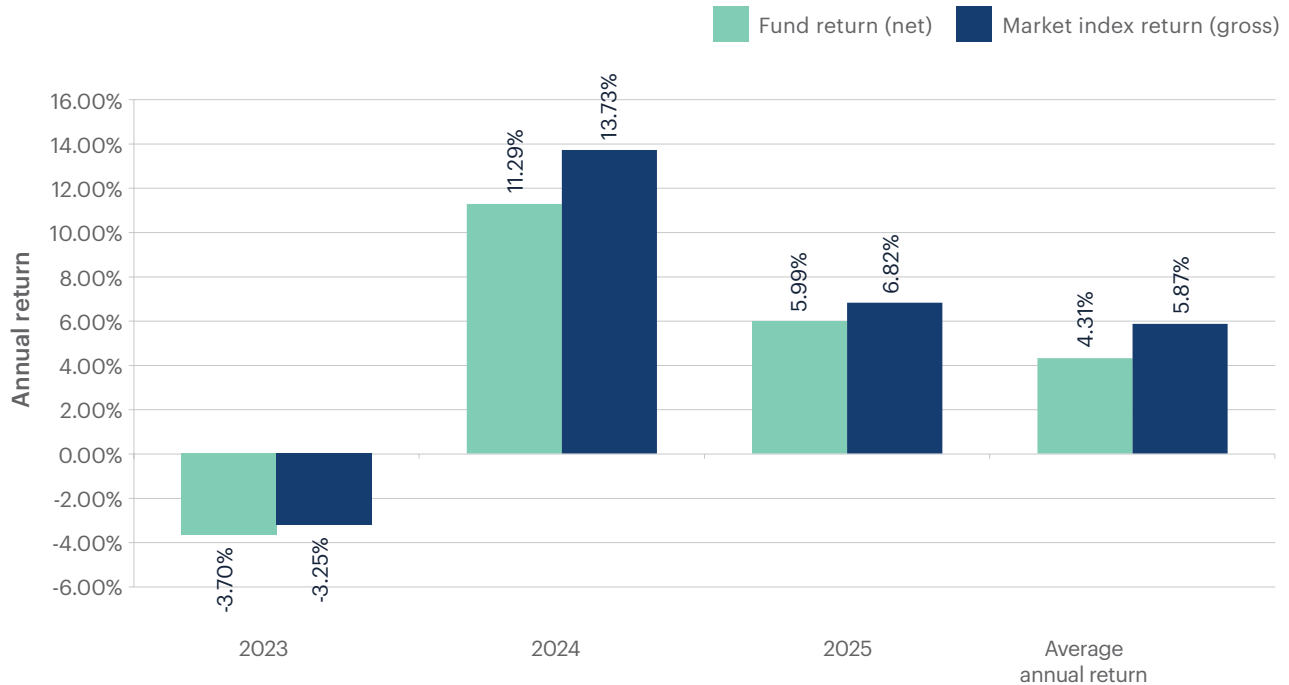

How has the fund performed?

The market index is a composite of S&P and Bloomberg published and unpublished indices, weighted for the fund's target investment mix. Following a recent strategic asset allocation review, the market index changed on 30 September 2025 to reflect changes to the target investment mix. The specific indices used for each asset class are set out in the Statement of Investment Policy and Objectives (SIPO). Annual return graph



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each year ending 31 March since the fund started. The last bar shows the average annual return since the fund started, up to 30 September 2025.

Returns in this update are after tax at the highest prescribed investor rate (PIR) of tax for an individual New Zealand resident. Your tax may be lower. The market index return reflects no deduction for charges and tax.

What fees are investors charged?

Investors in the Default Fund are charged fund charges. In the year to 31 March 2025 these were:

An annual fund charge of 0.37% applies to Default Fund investments – unless your Default Fund balance is \$1,500 or less, in which case no annual fund charge applies.

GST is not included in any of the fees stated and will be added where required.

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.



Example of how this applies to an investor

Alice had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Alice received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$999 (that is 9.99% of her initial \$10,000). This gives Alice a total return after tax of \$999 for the year.

Notes
