This fund update was first made publicly available on 30 April 2024.

What is the purpose of this update?

This document tells you how the Smartshares Global Bond ETF has performed and what fees were charged. The document will help you to compare the fund with other funds. Smartshares Limited prepared this update in accordance with the Financial Markets Conduct Act 2013. This information is not audited and may be updated.

Description of this fund

Invests in international bonds, with the objective of outperforming the Bloomberg Global Aggregate Bond Index by 1% per annum over rolling 3-year periods, hedged to the New Zealand dollar. The investment manager is PIMCO Australia Pty Ltd.

Total value of the fund: \$162,011,332

The date the fund started: 12 November 2015

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Smartshares Global Bond ETF



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher

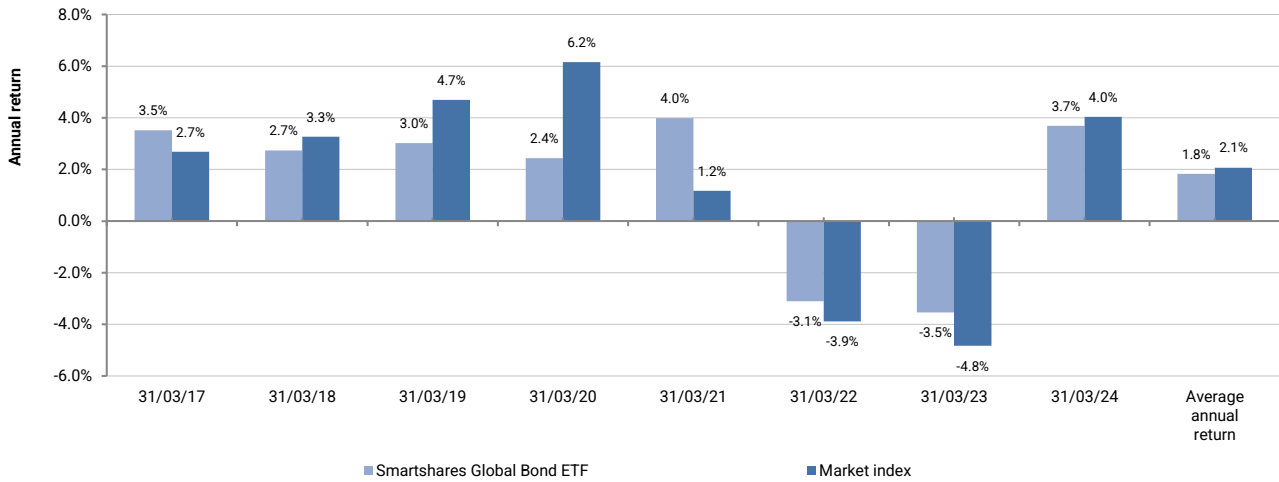
How has the fund performed?

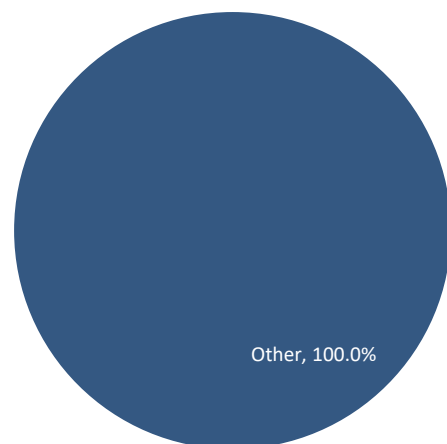
Example of how this applies to an investor

Tara had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Tara received a return after fund charges were deducted but before tax of \$512 (that is 5.12% of Tara's initial \$10,000). This gives Tara a total return after tax of \$369 for the year.

Currency hedging

As at 28 March 2024 the fund's exposure to assets denominated in foreign currencies was 101.00%, of which 99.94% was hedged. This means the fund's unhedged foreign currency exposure was 0.06% of the net asset value of the fund.
