What is the purpose of this update?

Description of this fund

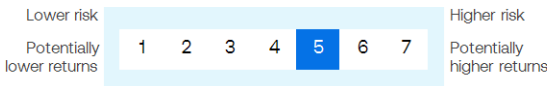
The Property Securities Fund invests mainly in New Zealand and Australian listed property assets. Investments may include companies, funds or trusts that invest in property and are listed or intend to list, and cash and cash equivalents.

The Property Securities Fund aims to achieve a return (after the fund charge and before tax) that over the long-term outperforms the relevant market index.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Property Securities Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

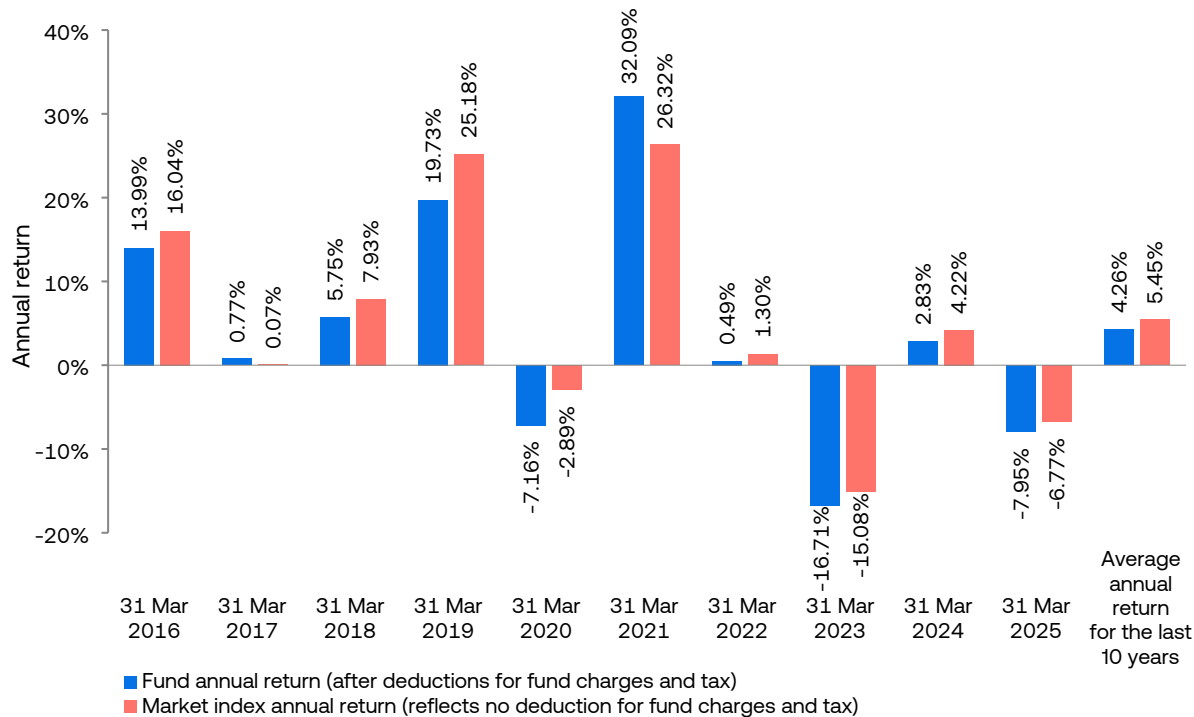
How has the fund performed?

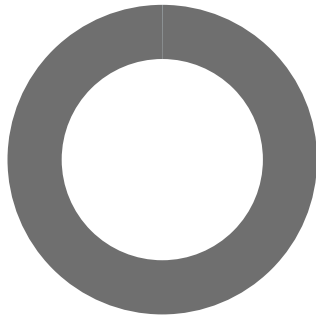
Example of how this applies to an investor

Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,013 (that is 10.13% of her initial \$10,000). Sarah did not pay any other charges. This gives Sarah a total return after tax of \$1,013 for the year.

Actual investment mix²

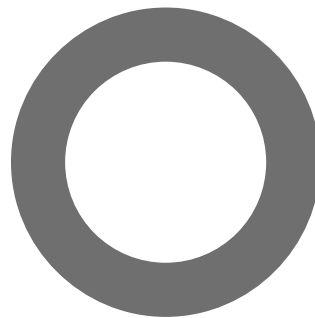
This shows the types of assets that the fund invests in.
