What is the purpose of this update?

Description of this fund

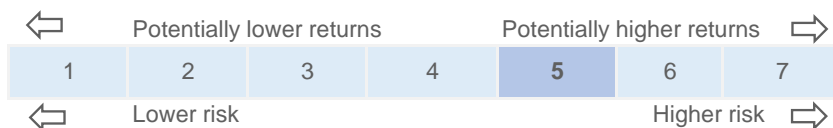
Objective: To provide a total return, before costs and tax, higher than the MSCI ACWI Index - Net over the long term.

Strategy: The underlying investment exposure is predominantly to a broad range of international shares listed on stock exchanges in developed markets and emerging international markets. Derivatives may be used to obtain or reduce exposure to securities and markets, to implement investment strategies and to manage risk.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Russell Investments Global Shares Fund.



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

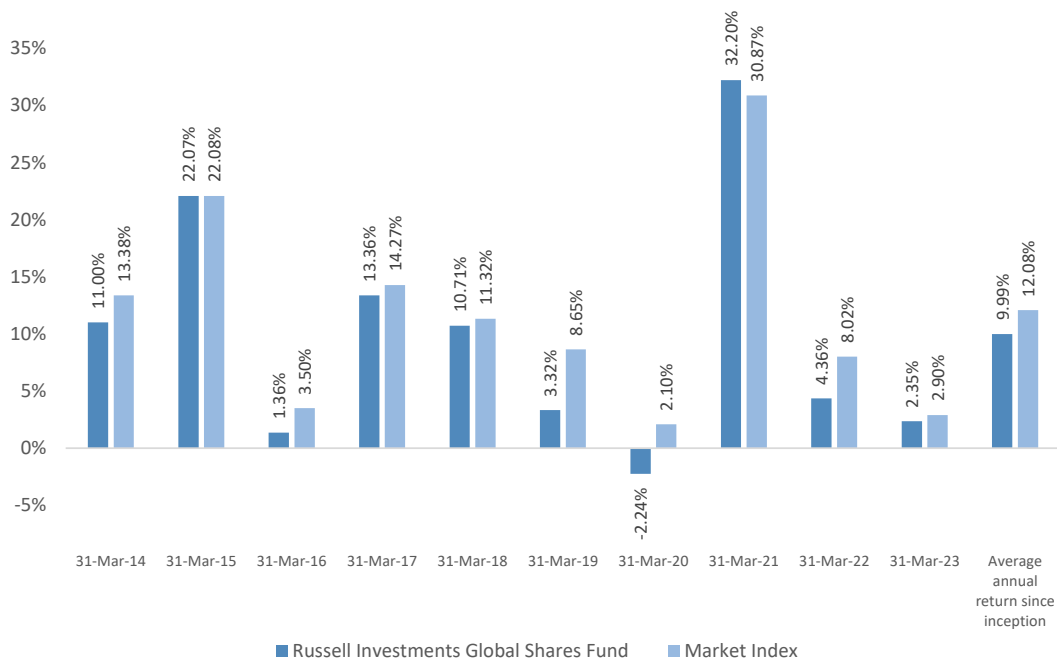

How has the fund performed?

This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each year ending 31 March since the fund started. The last bar shows the average annual return since the fund started, up to 31 December 2023.

Example of how this applies to an investor

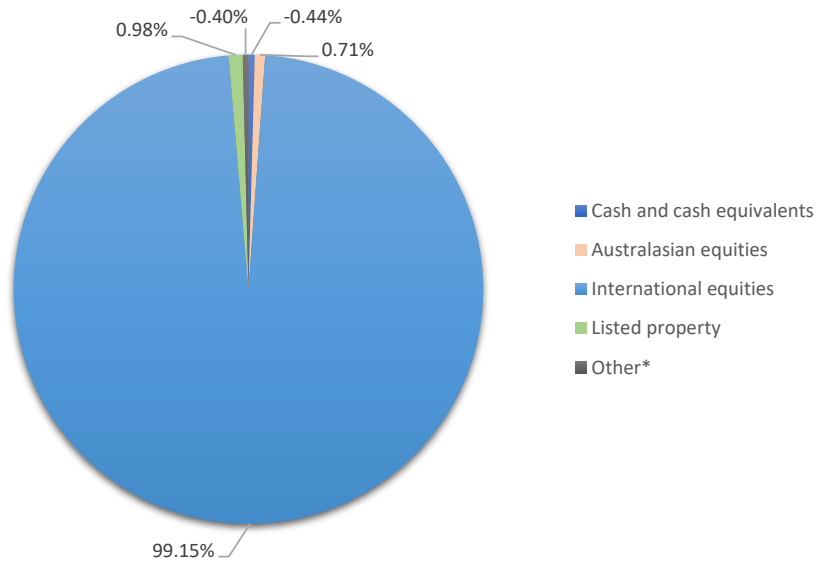
Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.

Anthony had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Anthony received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,779 (that is 17.79% of his initial \$10,000). This gives Anthony a total return after tax of \$1,580 for the year.

This shows the types of assets that the fund invests in.

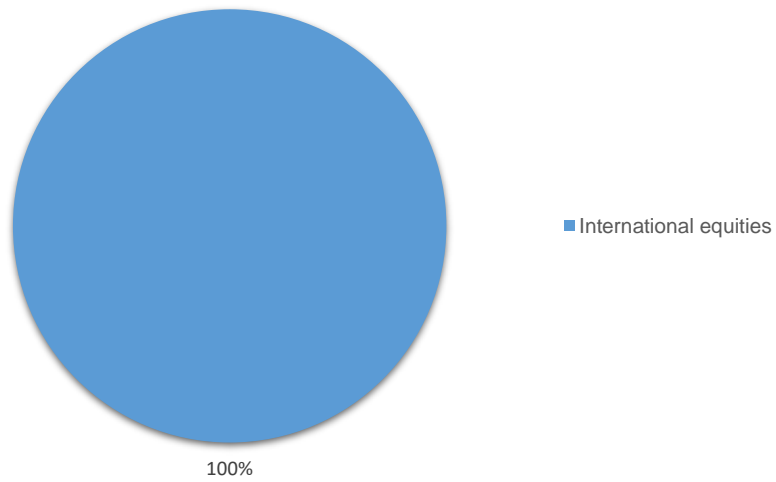
Actual investment mix
