#### What is the purpose of this update?

#### What are the risks of investing?


#### How has the fund performed?

#### Annual return graph



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for the last 10 years ending 31 March. The last bar shows the average annual return for the last 10 years, up to 30 September 2024.

#### What fees are investors charged?

Investors in the Trans Tasman Equity Trust are charged fund charges that include GST. In the year to 31 March 2024 these were:

# Example of how this applies to an investor


Sarah had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Sarah received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$1,954 (that is 19.54% of her initial \$10,000). Sarah did not pay other charges. This gives Sarah a total return after tax of \$1,954 for the year.



#### What does the fund invest in?

#### **Currency hedging**

The benchmark currency hedge ratio for Australian equities is 70% hedged into NZD. At quarter end the fund was 74.5% hedged into NZD.
