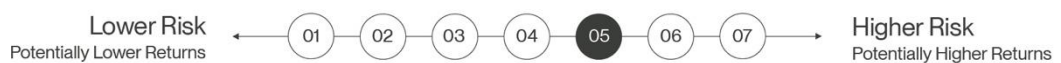
Description of this fund

The Fund invests in international equities and listed property that satisfy Pathfinder's ethical investment criteria. It achieves this by investing in Pathfinder's wholesale Responsible Investment Fund.

What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the Pathfinder Global Responsibility Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

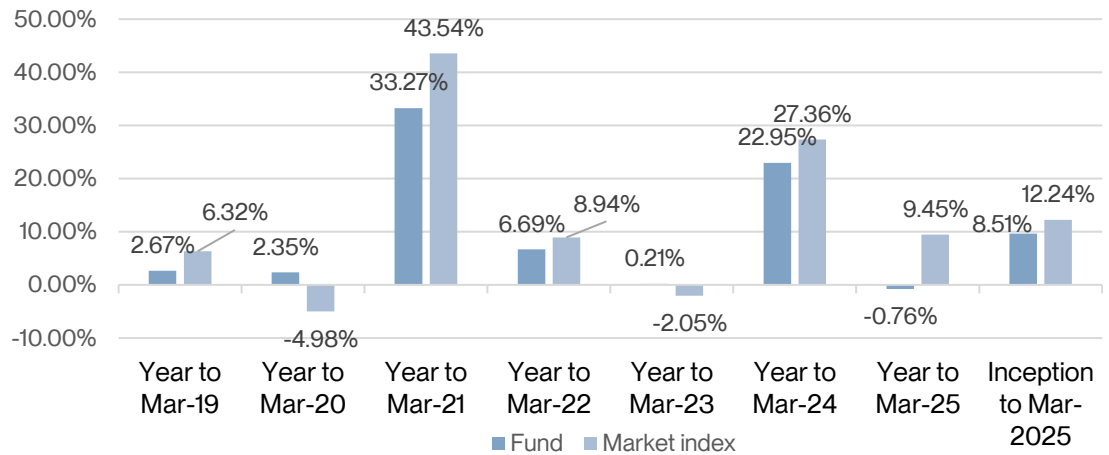
How has the fund performed?

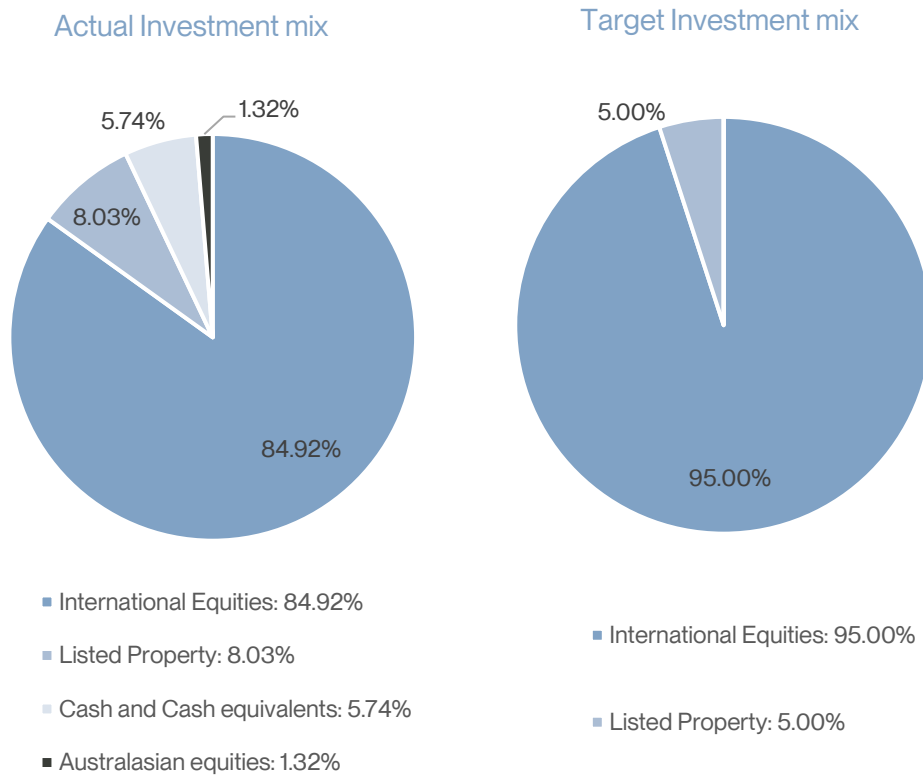
Example of how this applies to an investor

Angela had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Angela received a return after fund charges were deducted of \$27 (that is 0.27% of her initial \$10,000). Angela did not pay any other charges. This gives Angela a total loss after charges and tax of \$76 for the year.

The top 10 investments make up 22.02% of the net asset value of the fund.

Currency hedging: Changes in the value of the NZ dollar relative to other currencies can have a big impact on your investment over the long term. The target currency hedging level implemented in the fund is 50% of foreign currency exposures (actual hedging level at 31 March 2025 was 50.51%, this will change over time). The unhedged foreign currency exposure is 47.13% of the Net Asset Value of the Fund at 31 March 2025 (this will change over time).
