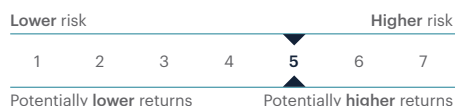
### Description of this Fund

The fund focuses on growth of your investment over the long term by investing in quality New Zealand companies which can consistently produce increasing earnings.

### What are the risks of investing?

Risk indicator for the New Zealand Growth Fund:



The risk indicator is rated from 1 (low) to 7 (high). The rating reflects how much the value of the fund's assets goes up and down. A higher risk generally means higher potential returns over time, but more ups and downs along the way.

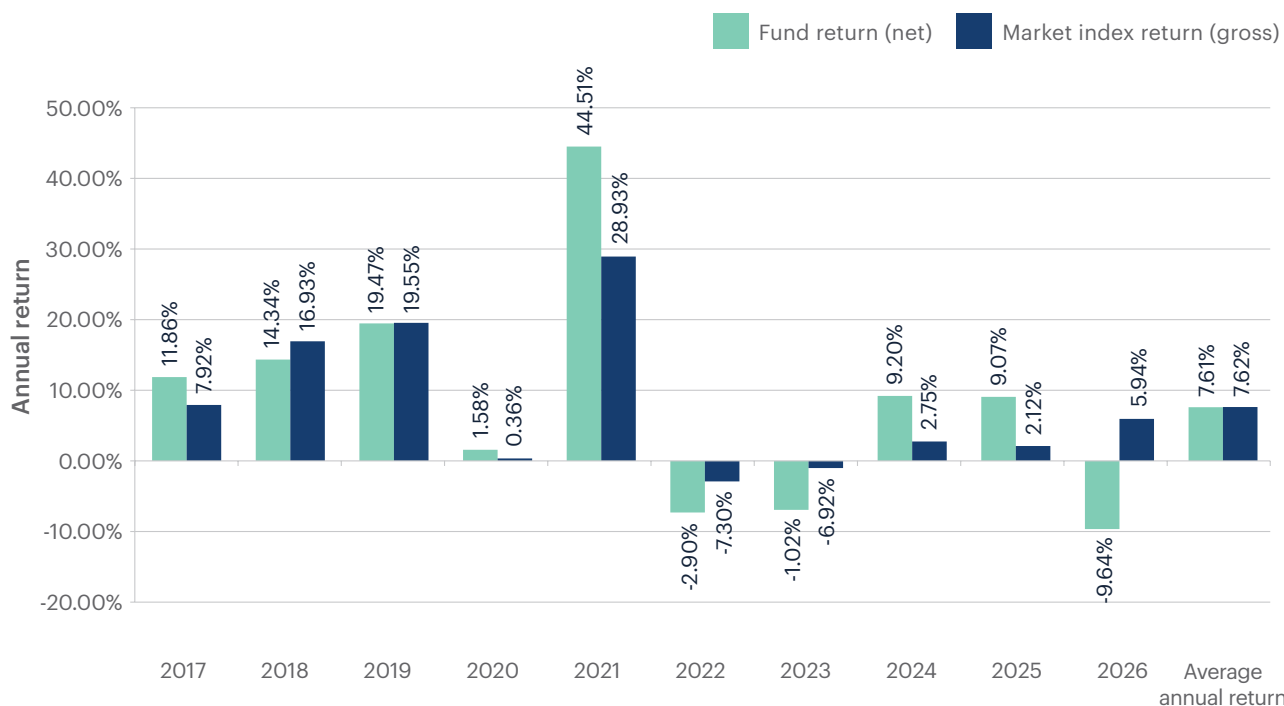

### How has the fund performed?

## Annual return graph



This shows the return after fund charges and tax for each of the last 10 years ending 31 March. The last bar shows the average annual return for the last 10 years, up to 31 March 2026.

## What fees are investors charged?

Investors in the New Zealand Growth Fund are charged fund charges that include GST. In the year to 31 March 2025 these were:

Small differences in fees and charges can have a big impact on your investment over the long term.



### Example of how this applies to an investor

Katie had \$10,000 in the fund at the start of the year and did not make any further contributions. At the end of the year, Katie incurred a loss after fund charges were deducted of -\$964 (that is -9.64% of her initial \$10,000). Katie did not pay other charges. This gives Katie a total loss after tax of -\$964 for the year.

### Actual investment mix

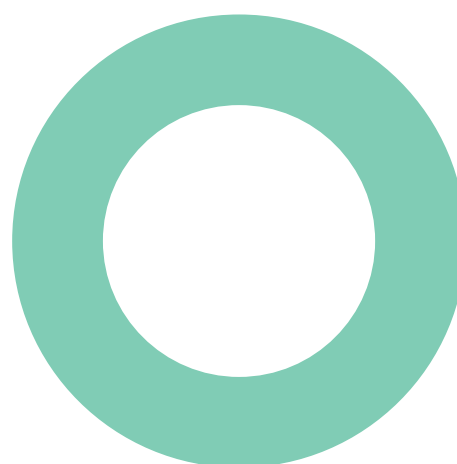
This shows the types of assets that the fund invests in.
